This event will include individual patterns, sparring, and team breaking. All divisions will be created on the day of the event at the discretion of the Chief Bracketeer.

The competition will be in accordance with USTF rules. Sparring gear including hand and foot pads, mouthpiece, headgear, and protective cup for male competitors will be required. <u>Headgear is mandatory for all ranks</u>. All referees and judges must be certified by the USTF and dressed properly in the official dress code established by the USTF.

(Team Breaking – 3 breakers per team, must be a green stripe or above, downward punch (knife hand for Peewees), side piercing kick (can be modified), and mid-air 180 back piercing kick (Blue Stripes and below can perform back piercing kick to D with rear leg). The hand breaks will use the UMAB (green-black) plastic boards. The foot breaking will use the PNP (tan/white/black) plastic boards.
